Fourth-placed Logan were looking to post a win to safeguard their finals spot against the fifth-placed Brothers who were determined to make their own charge towards the play-offs. The loss puts Logan in a dangerous situation with just two rounds to go, with next week's opponent the competition leaders, Sunnybank, followed by local rivals Redlands in the final round of fixtures. The clash between the Saints and Brothers was a tough affair as would be expected between two sides vying for finals positions. A single converted try separated the sides as Logan winger Jarom Mareikura crossed the line for a five-pointer and half-back Tim Burrows kicked a penalty goal for the Saints. But Brothers managed to score twice through their backs along with a penalty goal of their own to put away a desperate Logan team. The loss leaves Logan clinging to fourth place with 47 competition points. GPS, in third place, are likely to be out of reach for the Saints as they are 9 competition points ahead but the danger comes from Brothers who are just 5 points behind Logan.
