It was the boot of half-back Tim Burrows which kept the Saints in touch with the competition's leading team as he kicked six penalty goals to score all of the Saints points.

But it was to no avail, as the Logan attack was effectively shut down by tight Dragon's defence and while the Saints found it difficult with ball in hand, Sunnybank managed to cross the line four times to claim the win and a bonus point.

The strong Dragons side caused the Logan defence problems, and three of the visiting team's tries came through the backline and their solid attacking display signalled to the Saints the standard which they'll have to match if they are to have a chance in the closing stages of the season.

Logan were awarded a bonus point by losing by less than 7 points which places them on 48 competition points and clinging to fourth place and a potential finals place.

Brothers will host the second-last placed Wests Bulldogs while the Logan Saints travel to take on their local rivals, the last-placed Redlands Mudcrabs at Judy Holt Park.
